

BLUFFS REGIONAL PARK LOOP

- 3.06 mile total section with loop and overlooks
- Trailhead with parking lot at south end of Crooked Stick Trail Road
- Two overlooks with stunning views north and west to the Front Range
- **SURFACE:** wide, soft-surface dirt/ gravel path
- **DIFFICULTY:** easy-to-moderate
- **GOOD FOR:** hiking, biking, trail running, kids, some strollers

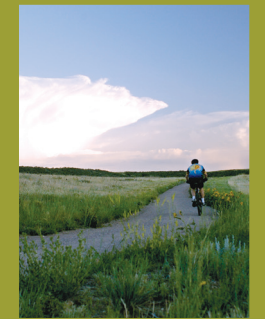
WILLOW CREEK TRAIL

- 0.66 mile section
- Trailhead with parking lot at Crossington Way, just south of the Prairie Sky Park baseball field
- Leads to *High Point Council Circle* sandstone sculpture at summit
- **SURFACE:** dirt and rock with native grassy areas
- **DIFFICULTY:** easy-to-moderate (some steeper sections)
- **GOOD FOR:** hiking, trail running, older kids, no strollers



EAST-WEST REGIONAL TRAIL

- 2.96 mile section
- Trailhead with on-street parking by Cabela's store (RidgeGate Parkway and Cabela Drive), or access from Bluffs Regional Park trails or Willow Creek Trail
- New section opened in 2013
- **SURFACE:** crusher fine gravel
- **DIFFICULTY:** easy
- **GOOD FOR:** hiking, biking, equestrians, trail running, kids, some strollers
